The Chairman declared a non-pecuniary interest under Item 03/0078 and took no part in that part of the Meeting the Chair then being taken by the Vice-Chairman

LAND ADJACENT TO CUSGARNE SCHOOL 03/0077

The Chairman the Clerk and other Councillors had attended a meeting at Cusgarne School when it became apparent that this land was to be auctioned on 5th November as its purchase could either assist the parking problems at the school or assist in the Councils aims to create a village centre. The Clerk advised that its acquisition for the former purpose would be outside the powers of the Council. The Council was interested for the second purpose but it was recognised that there was insufficient time available to carry out the normal searches and, in particular, (a) to obtain engineering assurance that the land was suitable for development and (b) to obtain planning permission. As any acquisition at this stage would be prejudicial to the Council's obligation to protect the public purse **IT WAS RESOLVED** not to bid at the auction. If the property fails to sell at auction the Clerk will write to the education authority to see if the Council and the authority can work in partnership to achieve their respective aims.
