*The Parish Council has the absolute right to consent to or refuse the erection or laying down of any stone or any inscription thereon. The term 'Headstone' shall include the provision of a vase. No consent will be granted for any gravestone exceeding 3 feet in overall height and 2 feet six inches in overall width (two feet for ashes plots) or any gravestone including a kerbed surround or similar. The Council may, at its absolute discretion, approve the inclusion in the headstone of a proper and dignified photograph of the deceased not exceeding 4 inches square. All stones must be erected or re-erected (as the case may be) in accordance with the recommendations from time to time of the National Association of Monumental Masons.

The New Section of Frogpool Cemetery is designated as a Lawn Cemetery and the Council reserves the right to remove any kerbstones or other obstructions without notice and without compensation. If the Council shall allow such kerbstones or other obstructions to remain in place such shall not be deemed to form either a deemed consent thereto or a precedent in respect of other plots.

Liability for the cost of removal of any kerbstones shall rest with the monumental mason installing the same without consent and shall be payable by the monumental mason on demand under the signature of the Clerk for the time being of Gwennap Parish Council

All fees stated above are payable forthwith. Non-payment of fees in respect of the purchase of any plot or for consent to erect or lay down a stone shall render void such purchase or consent and in the case of the latter any stone erected or laid down shall be removed forthwith by the monumental mason concerned on demand under the signature of the Clerk for the time being of Gwennap Parish Council. In default of removal the Council will remove the same the cost of so doing to be paid by the monumental mason forthwith on demand as aforesaid.

The fees etc. under the heading 'Parishioners' apply where the person interred or in respect of whom the right is granted is, at or immediately before the date of death was, an inhabitant of the Parish of Gwennap. In the case of a still-born child they apply where the parents or one of them is/are inhabitants of the said Parish at the time of interment.
