### CODE OF CONDUCT 02/0001

The Clerk explained the content and import of The Parish Councils (Model Code of Conduct) order 2001 and The Local Elections (Declarations of Acceptance of Office) Order 2001 and IT WAS **RESOLVED** that the model code as transcribed by the Clerk on to Parish paper was to be adopted on the date upon which the Clerk was satisfied that he was in a position to properly formulate a Register of Members Financial and other interests under Article 12 of the Code to meet with the requirements of the Monitoring Office

### STANDING ORDERS 02/0002

The Clerk explained that the only Standing Orders he had found in distributable form were issued in 1958 or thereabouts (notwithstanding that the Council had, allegedly, adopted a set in 1992 or thereabouts) and that whatever had been issued previously needed up-dating particularly in view if the new Code of Conduct and subject to the Clerk first altering the draft before the Council

- (a) to refer to meetings being on the fourth Thursday of the month
- (b) to include a provision permitting the Chairman with the consent of the Council to allow a non-member parishioner to speak if a useful contribution could be made to a debate and
- (c) to include a provision that each meeting should close at 10 p.m. unless there were agenda items which could not be deferred **IT WAS RESOLVED** to adopt the Standing Orders laid before the Council with immediate effect

### CLERKS CONTRACT 02/0003

**IT WAS RESOLVED** that the Clerks Contract in the form laid before the Council should be signed subject to the Clerks remuneration and benefits being reviewed at the time of the preparation

of the Precept Requirement rather than at the Annual Parish Meeting on the basis that the latter date was too late to be effective without prejudicing the finances of the Council
