PARISHIONERS' DISCUSSION

Mr. Jory made representations on his Planning Application (see below) stating that he had made efforts to let as commercial premises and was now running calculations about possible holiday letting.

Mr Scarratt made representations about the Planning Application of JB Timber Buildings who were his immediate neighbours and created much noise in summer. He was labouring under the misapprehension that the consent allowed the applicants to make as much noise as was necessary and was advised to represent his concerns to CDC.

PC Wheeler stated that there had been 1 crime (theft at United Downs) and 26 reported incidents. The Clerk said he had had a complaint about youths at the Pulla Cross bus stop abusing passers-by and throwing stones at cars. PC Wheeler said he would try and have a word.

Cllr. Whiteley updated the Council on the dumping at Poldory where enforcement action is now under way both by CDC and the Environment Agency and the dust and odours monitoring at United Downs. Cllr. Massie was concerned that the level of monitoring fell far below the standards previously in place and Cllr Whiteley was asked to voice the Councils concerns to Mark Hitchens at CDC.

Cllr. Hichens confirmed that the missing @Slow' sign at Cusgarne was being replaced, that the Gwennap to Sunny Corner road was being patched as necessary, that the drain cover in Pencantol was to be fixed and that Dan Thomas was dealing with 'No horses' signs on the Hicks Mill footpath.

Cllr Snell said that the drains and ditches in Crofthandy were all blocked preventing rainwater to escape and Cllr Hichens noted

Prayers were said and the October 2002 Minutes signed as correct.
